## **VOLUNTEER SERVICE AREAS**

**Holidays and Special Events:** assist the activities staff in setting up events or in transporting residents by wheelchair to and from special functions

**Activities:** Visit one-on-one with residents; provide companionship, play games or read the newspaper, magazines or books. Assist with activities program such as bingo, coffee hour, current events, etc.

**Pet Therapy:** Bring a suitable pet to visit residents. All visiting pets must have current shot/immunizations records.

**Arts and Crafts:** Participate in arts and crafts and assist residents in artistic group activities

**Transport:** Assist staff in transporting residents to and from select activities including rehabilitation therapy

**Dining Services:** Assist in the set up of meal service for residents or help residents complete weekly menu selections.

**Clerical:** assist with filing, data entry, and mailings.

The Junior Volunteer Program offers youth ages 14 -18 an opportunity to participate in departments throughout the nursing center.
